



Steven L. Reed - **Probate Judge** Steven Reed was elected Montgomery County Probate Judge in November 2012.

Judge Reed was born and raised in Montgomery where he attended public schools and where he was active in sports and YMCA programs from his early youth through high school. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree, cum laude, from Morehouse College and a Master of Business Administration from Vanderbilt University's Owen Graduate School of Management.

Judge Reed began his professional career as a financial analyst in the Marketing Performance department at American Airlines corporate headquarters in Ft. Worth, TX. He also understands the impact of small businesses as the former managing partner of a national retail franchise.

He serves on the Britton Ave. YMCA board and is a past member of the Montgomery County Planning Commission.
